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Update on restoration of supply at PowerGen Pt. Lisas Power Station on 06 August, 2022

This morning, at 9:11 a.m. there was an electrical fault at the Point Lisas Switchyard (which connects the generators to the Electricity Grid). This led to the operation of the automatic protection system and loss of generation from three (3) of the eleven (11) Units at the Point Lisas Power Station, amounting to approximately 200MW to the National Grid across Trinidad.
