The Power Generation Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (PowerGen) has donated three (3) fully-equipped video laryngoscopes to the Ministry of Health. On December 30th, 2020 at a handover ceremony hosted at the Ministry of Health's Head Office, PowerGen's Acting General Manager- Mr. Dharmendra Singh made the presentation to the Minister of Health – The Honourable Terrence Deyalsingh.

The laryngoscopes will be utilised at the Emergency Rooms of the Port of Spain and San Fernando General Hospitals as well as the Eric Williams Medical Sciences Complex. A laryngoscope is a device which allows a medical professional to examine a patient's throat and larynx (voice box) at a safe distance.

This donation formed part of PowerGen's "We Care for our Country" campaign which sought to provide support of our national community during the COVID-19 pandemic. Other donations included seventy-three (73) Nano-SIM enabled tablets to the Ministry of Education's Adopt-A-School Programme, food hampers distributed to two hundred and fifty (250) needy families and partnerships with organisations in the areas of sustainable agriculture and retraining of unemployed and underemployed citizens.
